

NEW JERSEY FLOUNDER REGULATIONS

Atlantic States Marine Fisheries Commission draft addendum XXVIII to the summer flounder, scup and black sea bass fishery management plan.

Regulations in place for summer **2016:**

| | Size limit | Bag limit | Length of season |

| New Jersey | 18 inches | 5 fish | 128 days |
| NJ Delaware Bay | 17 inches | 4 fish | 128 days |
| Special Site Long Island Beach State Park | 16 inches | 4 fish | 128 days |

Proposed regulation options for summer **2017:**

| New Jersey | | | |
| Option 1 | 18 inches | 2 fish | 59 days |
| Option 2 | 19 inches | 3 fish | 96 days |
| Options 3 and 4 * | 19 inches | 3 fish | 99 days |
| Option 5 | | | |
| NJ Delaware Bay | 18 inches | 3 fish | 128 days |

There are no special regulations for bay and Long Island Beach State Park, which can be added later.

* There's no difference for N.J. between these options. The regulations are coastwide. Other states have different limits for each option.
