Reopening Plan Quick Reference

Dear LCMR Community:

This LCMR Reopening Quick Reference guide was prepared to assist efforts to communicate our plans for reopening schools this fall. Our entire reopening plan is available on our district website which details specifics regarding our reopening. This guide is to serve as a quick reference to the broad points of that plan. Our Reopening Task Force and the various reopening sub-committees are continuing the work of preparing for our reopening of school in a manner that will ensure the health, safety and wellbeing of all students and staff coming into our schools each day.

When schools reopen on September 8th, 2020, the district will use a hybrid schedule with four groups of students (Capers, Tigers, Pride, and Spirit) with each group attending school for in-person instruction one day per week, and virtual instruction the remainder of the week. Beginning Monday, September 21st, the district will increase student capacity by combining student groups into two segments (Capers/Tigers & Pride/Spirit) where each group will attend school for in-person learning two days a week and virtual instruction the remaining three days. Each Wednesday on a normal five day week will be a virtual learning day for all students.

SOCIAL DISTANCING Reducing student attendance capacity each day enables effective social distancing but all staff and students will be reminded to follow all required protocols.

LCMR SCHOOL DISTRICT RESTART PLAN

- Schools open Tuesday, September 8, 2020
- The first week of school will have early dismissal each day for students
- During the first two weeks of school, students will attend school for inperson learning one day per week, virtual learning the remaining days. Student capacity during the first two weeks will be at 25%.
- Beginning September 21st, students will attend schools in-person two days each week, and attend classes via virtual instruction the remaining three days. Student capacity under this schedule will be at 50%.
- An All Virtual option will be made available. Contact building principals to request that option.
- Masks required for all staff and students in school and on busses.
- Protocols will be put in place for increased cleaning and disinfecting of
- Busses will be traveling at the same capacity as each school (25% or 50%) to allow for social distancing. Parents are encouraged to drive their students to school if possible.
- **Approval of COVID-19** protocols by NJ Department of Health.

TRANSPORTATION TO SCHOOL

Students will be required to wear face masks on school busses at all times. All riders must follow social distancing guidelines. Parents are encouraged to drive their students to and from school each day if possible.

SCHOOL CALENDAR 180 DAYS

Although instructional methods may be adjusted during the year, our plan is to adhere to the published LCMR 2020-21 School Calendar to meet NJ State requirements.

SCHOOL MEALS

Due to the reduced student capacity each day, LCMR will continue to serve MASKS. Staff and students must wear masks at all times meals in our cafeterias and preserve adequate social distancing. Table dividers will be used to provide further protection while students are eating. All surfaces and tables will be disinfected before and after each meal. Meals will be provided to all students during their virtual days via delivery in school prior to leaving for their assigned virtual days and through designated distribution sites in the community.
