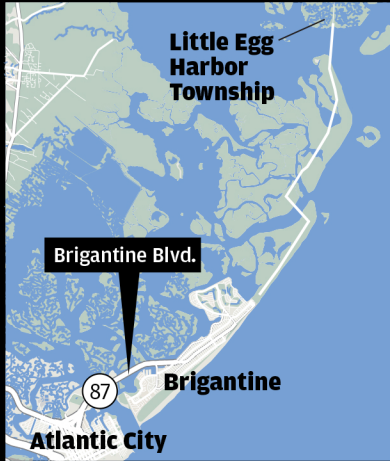


In 1927, a law was enacted to construct Route S4A, connecting Little Egg Harbor to Brigantine and Atlantic City via Little Beach. Roughly \$578,000 (about \$10 million today) was issued to complete the project. Only the portion of the road in Ocean County was completed, now known as Great Bay Boulevard, or Seven Bridges Road. Due to highway numbering changes and the reality of the road never being completed, route S4A became what is now Route 87, connecting Atlantic City and Brigantine.
