The School Day



Staff and students will wear face coverings throughout the school day unless accommodations are needed.



Staff and students will be asked to wash and sanitize their hands frequently and will have routine handwashing breaks throughout the day.



Staff and students will maintain a safe distance. Students will be reminded to keep their hands to themselves with no high-fives, hugs, or shared school supplies.

STARTING THE DAY

SCHOOL MEALS
