## **CHANGES WE COULD SEE IF CONGRESS PASSES TAX REFORM**

## **STANDARD DEDUCTION**

**Current:** \$6,350 if single; \$12,700 if married **House bill:** \$12,000 if single; \$24,000 if married **Senate bill:** \$12,000 if single; \$24,000 if married

## **CHILD TAX CREDIT**

**Current:** \$1,000 credit for each child; credit phased out at \$110,000

**House bill:** \$1,600 credit for each child; \$300 credit for each parent and non-child dependent; credits phased out at \$230,000 (if married)

Senate bill: \$2,000 credit per child; \$500 credit for non-minor child dependents; credits phased out at \$500,000 (if married)

## STATE AND LOCAL TAX DEDUCTION (SALT)

**Current:** Income, sales and property taxes are fully deductible for itemizers

**House bill:** Repeals state and local tax deductions for income and sales tax; caps property-tax deduction at \$10,000
