

Areas most likely for shore's oldest to be flooded

According to research by ClimateCentral, roughly 11,000 people older than 85 years old live in areas that would experience some flooding in a Sandy-like scenario. An estimated 1,786 people over 85 would be completely underwater again. The locations listed all have a percentage of residents over 85 that is higher than the U.S. average and statistically significant.
