ORDINANCE NO. 1064

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 10, BUSINESSES,
REGARDING BACKGROUND INVESTIGATIONS AND
MESSAGE THERAPY BUSINESSES

On the 3rd day of August, 2026 the Shoreview City Council adopted ordinance 1064 amending chapter 10, articles II, licensing, and VIII, message establishments. On the same day, pursuant to Minn. Stat. §412.191, Subd. 4, the Shoreview City Council directed that a summary of ordinance 1064 be published.

Ordinance 1064 adds complementary and alternative health care (CAHC) licenses to the list of licenses the Sheriff's Office will conduct background investigations on. It also adds language requiring a third-party background check for license applicants who have not held residency in Minnesota for the preceding five years. Furthermore, it updates language to include definitions, licensing requirements, and regulations for CAHC practices, practitioners, and establishments. It also adds updates establishment

restrictions for businesses practicing massage therapy or CAHC. A copy of the ordinance is available for inspection by any person during regular business hours at the office of the city manager, 4600 North Victoria Street, Shoreview, Minnesota 55126.
