## Grayson Eggum

### Stillwater Wrestling

Grayson Eggum, Stillwater sophomore wrestler, is ranked No. 1 in Class 3A at 160 pounds with a 14-1 record, after capturing the state championship at 139 pounds last season with a 38-4 record. Eggum placed second at 160 pounds in the 50-team MatBoss Minnesota Christmas tournament, losing 4-3 in the finals to Class 2A's No.1 Cooper Rowe of Mound-Westonka. He is the son of Gopher's wrestling coach Brandon Eggum.



## Brynne Laska

### Stillwater Hockey

Brynne Laska, Stillwater junior forward, has logged eight goals and nine assists for 17 points, most in a very balanced attack by the Ponies (13-2-1). In recent games, the 5-foot-4 left-hander had two goals in a 4-3 win over Forest Lake, and a goal and assist in a 6-1 win over Shakopee. Laska also competes in cross country and track, and placed fourth in Section 4AAA in the 800 meters.



## DJ Westman

### Forest Lake Basketball

DJ Westman, Forest Lake point guard, leads the Rangers (3-4) with 16 points and 4.6 assists per game while also averaging 3.6 rebounds and one steal. He's hitting 93% of his free shots. The 5-foot-11 senior averaged 16 points as a junior and six points as a sophomore. He has 528 career points. His other sport is football as a wide receiver with 23 catches, 232 yards, and four touchdowns for an 8-2 team.



## Aubree Hultman

### Forest Lake Basketball

Aubree Hultman has led the Forest Lake basketball team to an 8-1 start, averaging 17 points per game. The 5-foot-5 senior guard has committed to Dakota State University. She had 24 points in a win over Centennial and 27 in a win over Andover. This is her fourth varsity season. She averaged 16 points as a junior, 8.7 as a sophomore and 9.3 as a freshman.
