ORDINANCE NO. 171
(SECOND SERIES)
(ORDINANCE SUMMARY)**

AN ORDINANCE REGARDING FIRE PREVENTION CODE

The City Council adopted Ordinance No. 171, replacing Chapter 9 of the City Code with a modern Fire Prevention Code that aligns with current Minnesota law. The ordinance adopts the Minnesota State Fire Code as the City's official fire code and updates local regulations related to fire prevention, life safety, consumer fireworks, and alarm systems. It also establishes clear standards for permits, inspections, enforcement, appeals, and penalties while providing updated requirements for open burning, fire protection systems, address identification, false alarm management, and emergency life safety measures. The ordinance takes effect following its official publication.

This summary is adopted pursuant to Minn. Stat. §299F.011.
