The ordinance establishes a new chapter in the City Code, which regulates mobile food vehicles and mobile food vendors, and requires that such business activities obtain a license from the city prior to operating. The ordinance also establishes procedural requirements for issuing denying, suspending, and revoking such licenses, and it further implements certain regulations relating to said business activities to further public health, safety, and welfare.
