NOTICE OF AERIAL HERBICIDE APPLICATION ON STATE LANDS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources is planning to conduct aerial application of an herbicide labeled for aquatic use via helicopter to control cattail vegetation and improve waterfowl habitat within the water impoundments at Carlos Avery Wildlife Management Area in Anoka County. The four treatment areas total approximately 240 acres in size and are located on the main unit of the Wildlife Management Area at pools 6, 8, 15 and 16. The project is likely to occur between August 23 and September 8, 2017, depending on weather and site conditions. Notice signs will be posted at entry points and on-site prior to spraying.
