Forest Lake Softball

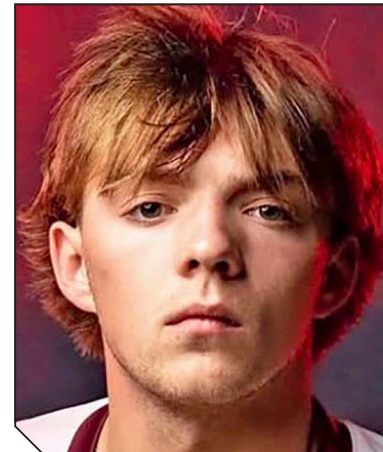
