ORDINANCE 26-08-2086
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF WHITE BEAR LAKE REGARDING ILLICIT DISCHARGE DETECTION AND ELIMINATION

The Council of the City of White Bear Lake does ordain the following:

ARTICLE I. Subsection 406.020(3)(p) of the Municipal Code is hereby amended by deleting the stricken language and adding the double-underlined language as follows: p. Public waters. Waters of the state, as defined in Minn. Stat. § 103G.05Q5(15).

ARTICLE II. Subsection 406.020(8) of the Municipal Code is hereby amended by deleting the stricken language and adding the double-underlined language as follows: f. Salt Storage. Proper salt storage is required at commercial, institutional, and non-NPDES permitted industrial facilities to prevent negative environmental impacts. The following best management practices are required:

- (1) Designated salt storage areas must be covered or indoors.
- (2) Designated salt storage areas must be located on an impervious surface.
- (3) Practices must be implemented in designated salt storage areas to minimize exposure during material transfer (e.g., sweeping, diversions, and/or containment).

ARTICLE III. Subsection 406.020(13)(a) of the Municipal Code of is hereby amended by deleting the stricken language as follows: a. When the City finds that any person has violated, or continues to violate, any provision of this ordinance, or any order issued hereunder and that the violation(s) has (have) caused or contributed to an actual or threatened discharge to the stormwater management system or waters of the state which reasonably appears to present an imminent and substantial endangerment to the environment, or to the health or welfare of persons, the City may issue and order to the violator to immediately cease and desist all violations.

ARTICLE IV. This ordinance shall become effective on the first day of publication after adoption.
