Section 1. That Chapter 203 of the Lino Lakes Code of Ordinances be amended to read as follows:

CHAPTER 203: COUNCIL COMPENSATION

§ 203.01 COMPENSATION OF MAYOR AND COUNCILMEMBERS. (1) Salaries. The compensation of the Mayor and each Council member

- shall be established from time to time by City Council ordinance pursuant to M.S. § 415.11. Effective January 1, 2024 2026, the annual salary of the Mayor shall be \$\frac{\frac{517}{17.298}}{10.423}\$. Thereafter, every two years the City Council will consider whether a salary adjustment is warranted.

 This salary is intended to cover all meetings that may be attended by the Mayor or Council members except as expressly provided in this

 (2) Payment. The annual salaries established hereby are to be paid monthly.
- (3) Economic Development Authority (EDA) meetings. The City Council will be compensated for attendance at EDA meetings at the rate of \$40 per meeting.
