Corina Lydia Contreras, 16, of 623 S. 34th St., came to Billings in 1963 with her parents, Reyes and Jennie Contreras, and was a sophomore at Billings Senior High School. She was found dead Friday about 11 miles east of Billings.

Born in Cleveland, Ohio, she attended Little Flower School, Riverside Junior High School. She was a member of the Youth Club at Our Lady of Guadalupe Catholic parish.

Her mother died in September, and her sister, Sharon Contreras, in November.
