# Where does the money go? Back to the community!

Throughout the year we constantly hear the question, "Where do the proceeds from Festival of Trees go?" All proceeds benefit Quad City Arts, a not-for-profit agency dedicated to the growth and vitality of the region through the presentation, development, and celebration of the arts. Serving a bi-state area including Rock Island, Henry and Mercer counties in Illinois and Scott, Clinton and Muscatine counties in Iowa, Quad City Arts has a staff of 6, a 30member board of directors and more than 150 community members serving on committees. Major programs include Quad City Arts Dollar\$ Re-granting Program, Gallery Exhibitions, Super

Author, Cary Grant Residency, Metro Arts, Public Sculpture Program, and Art @ the Airport.

Probably the most recognized program that receives funding from Festival is our Visiting Artists Series program. In its 37th season this program will bring 39 artists in 9 residencies to the Quad Cities reaching nearly 60,000 people in schools, (45,000 children K-12) workplaces, human service agencies, senior centers and public concert halls. Since 1974 dancers, musicians, writers, actors and visual artists in 328 residencies have reached more than 2,650,000 Quad City Children and adults through the Visiting Artist Series.

### The 10 most frequently asked questions about Festival of Trees

### Q. Who runs Festival?

Festival of Trees is chaired by volunteers with a steering committee of 125 volunteers from thirteen different communities on both sides of the river. The Steering Committee works year round with hundreds of committee members to organize the event and each year more than 3,500 volunteers staff the event.

### Q. How old is Festival?

This year, the Quad City Arts Festival of Trees is celebrating it's 25th birthday.

# Q. How does our Festival compare to other Festivals around the country?

Our local Festival of Trees ranks fifth in the United States and Canada in attendance and total dollars raised among such cities as Atlanta, Detroit, and Salt Lake City. For two years, our Festival representatives have served as chairperson of the Festival of Trees International Council. Quad City Arts Festival of Trees is one of only two Festivals of its kind where the proceeds benefit the arts and humanities.

### Q. Who provides the financial support for Festival?

Each year, more than 100 businesses serve as Festival sponsors, providing the critical seed money for Festival operations. Additionally, many designers generously donate their time and decorations to create the incredible designs that are shown and sold at Festival. More than 400 local businesses provide donations, services, and discounts for the event and in turn, the Festival of Trees Steering Committee has a strict policy of supporting local businesses whenever possible. However, Festival's success depends on the support of the thousands of people who attend Festival each year.

# Q. When is the best time to attend Festival if I want to browse leisurely through the trees?

Most people attend Festival during the holiday weekend when family and friends are in town. Evenings seem to be the most popular time of day. So, if it's open space you're after, you are better off coming early in the week and early in the day.



# Q. I love Festival and the community it celebrates. How do I get involved?

Each and every year, we hear someone say "I would love to be a part of Festival, but I've never been asked to help".

Well, consider this your official call to action! Festival is successful because of the hundreds of dedicated volunteers, designers, and sponsors.

The varied talents, personalities, skills and creative abilities pull together for one common goal: to bring quality arts programming to our community. We can use your help for one hour a day, one hour a week, or one hour a year. We are also always looking for new Steering Committee members to bring new ideas to our event to keep it fresh and new. ### Q. I really want to go to Festival, where do I get tickets?

General admission tickets are sold at the doors. Special event tickets are sold at the

RiverCenter North Box Office just outside the Mississippi Hall, Monday-Friday, 9 a.m.-3 p.m., starting November 1st through November 25th.

# Q. How are the trees and the many other designs sold at Festival of Trees?

The very first opportunity anyone has to purchase the designer trees, door designs, holiday entries, and hearth & home designs is at the Grand Premiere Party, Friday, November 19. (Tickets are \$60 each and can be purchased by calling 563/324-FEST.)

Each item will be for sale via silent auction bidding or raffle. Those items not receiving the minimum bid at the close of the silent auction Friday evening will then go on sale via a continuous silent auction method. This means that for the remaining days of Festival, November 20 – 28, the public may continuously bid on these items. Bidding will close on Sunday, November 28, at 3:00 p.m. For raffled items, these \$1 or \$5 raffle chances continue on throughout the entire 10 days of Festival. Winners are drawn at 4:00 p.m., on Sunday, November 28th, and called that evening.


Gingerbread creations, miniatures, stockings & ornaments and Table

### Q. Where can I go to get a good bite to eat?

There are a few places inside Festival that you can get a quick bite to eat. TreatShoppe, located in the RiverCenter South Great Hall, sells a variety of sweet candy treats and popcorn sure to satisfy snack cravings. The RiverCenter also has concessions available for purchase. However, if you are looking to venture outside for food, the Festival of Trees Guest Services, located in the South building's atrium, will help direct you and will feature maps, coupons and brochures from local businesses, restaurants and hotels. Volunteers working in this area will answer general questions about Festival and educate guests about local attractions, cultural events and great places to eat.

# Q. What kind of accommodations do you have for the elderly and is there an ATM located inside Festival?

The RiverCenter is wheelchair accessible, with elevators located on both North and South sides. The information Center, inside the Great Hall, has wheelchairs available to rent for the elderly with limited mobility. Wheelchairs are provided on a first come first serve basis, and require an ID to rent. ID's will be held until chairs are returned. The RiverCenter will have an ATM machine inside the building for public use located on the South side at the IH Mississippi Valley Credit Union.
