

Museum to Get Eagle Off Tower

Spanish Vets Withdraw Request for Court- house Emblem.

The gilded eagle off the courthouse dome was headed for a niche in the Davenport Public museum along with other Scott county relics.

This action was taken by the county board of supervisors after Walter Nagel camp, No. 10, United Spanish American Veterans, had withdrawn its request for the ornament.

The eagle which adorned the flag staff on the courthouse tower for more than 60 years, was removed following the decision of the board to dismantle the dome and tower.

Approve Pensions.

The board approved payment of \$2,828.77 in pensions to widows and mothers of dependent children, and \$813 to blind pensioners during the month of October.

The board adjourned to Dec. 11 when claims will be allowed.
