Unlike many coffee shops, we do not have a drive-thru that could have, potentially assisted in lost revenue. Our customers have come to love the beautiful view from inside our shop.

We've had additional challenges in our attempts, with some success of maintaining employment of our full-time employees. We have tried to recover losses, but have not been completely successful. The continual challenges of compliance with all the Executive Orders have had their unique hurdles, but we have, and we will continue to comply with all mandates and orders as directed.

It is our wish to continue to remain a viable business, as we have enjoyed successes in our business. A grant of \$5000.00 would be extremely helpful in allowing us to continue to be a viable business in the City of Moline.
