Corporate Challenge camps win by numbers

Winners in the Corporate Challenge portion of the 1990 Quad-City Times Biz 7 were Tech Graphics, Milan; Mercy Hospital, Davenport; and Osco Drug.

The three were among 96-area businesses that fielded 1,200 runners and walkers as part of the Corporate Challenge, a way of promoting physical fitness and health.

"We're pleased with the response, but we know we can do better next year," said Bill Klutho, chairman of the Corporate Challenge Committee.

A Biz 7 Corporate Challenge

was conducted as a pilot program last year, but it was not highly promoted.

Although corporate challenges in other races around the country use the latest times to determine winners, the Biz 7 Corporate Challenge winners were judged according to percentage of participation.

Companies were divided up into three categories, based on number of employees.

The winner in each category received a plaque.

1. Tech Graphics (87 percent

of 23 employees); 2. Ron Van Horn Construction, Randolph; 3. Alpine Hair Fashion, Davenport.

100 to 999 employees

1. Osco Drug (37 percent of 135 eligible employees); 2. Montague Elevator, Moline; 3. Linguist System Inc., East Moline.

1,000-plus employees

1. Mercy Hospital (23 percent of 1,000 eligible employees); 2. Aluminum Company of America, Davenport; 3. Davenport Community School District.

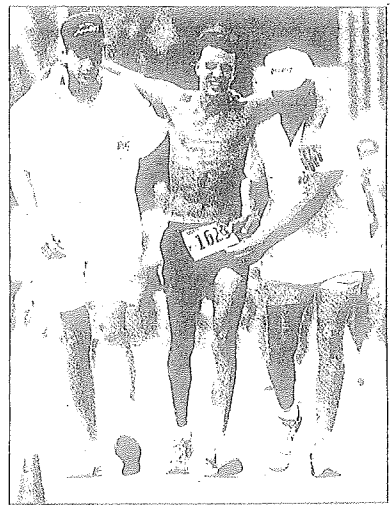

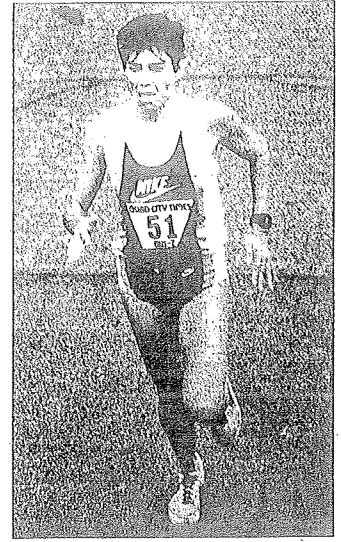

Stave and Sandy Merriman were ready to cheer on the 16,000-plus runners and walkers in the Bix 7.

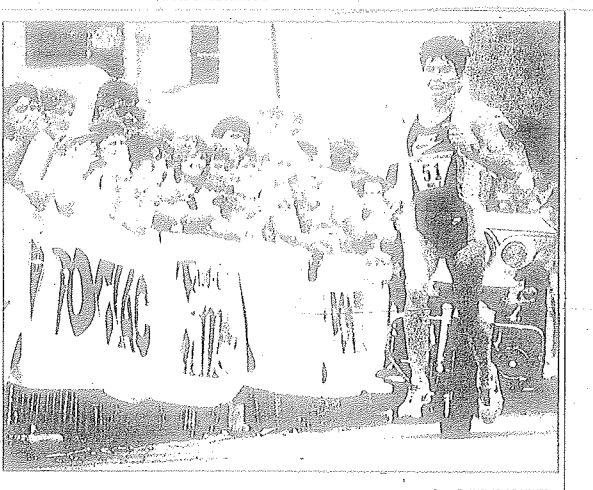
