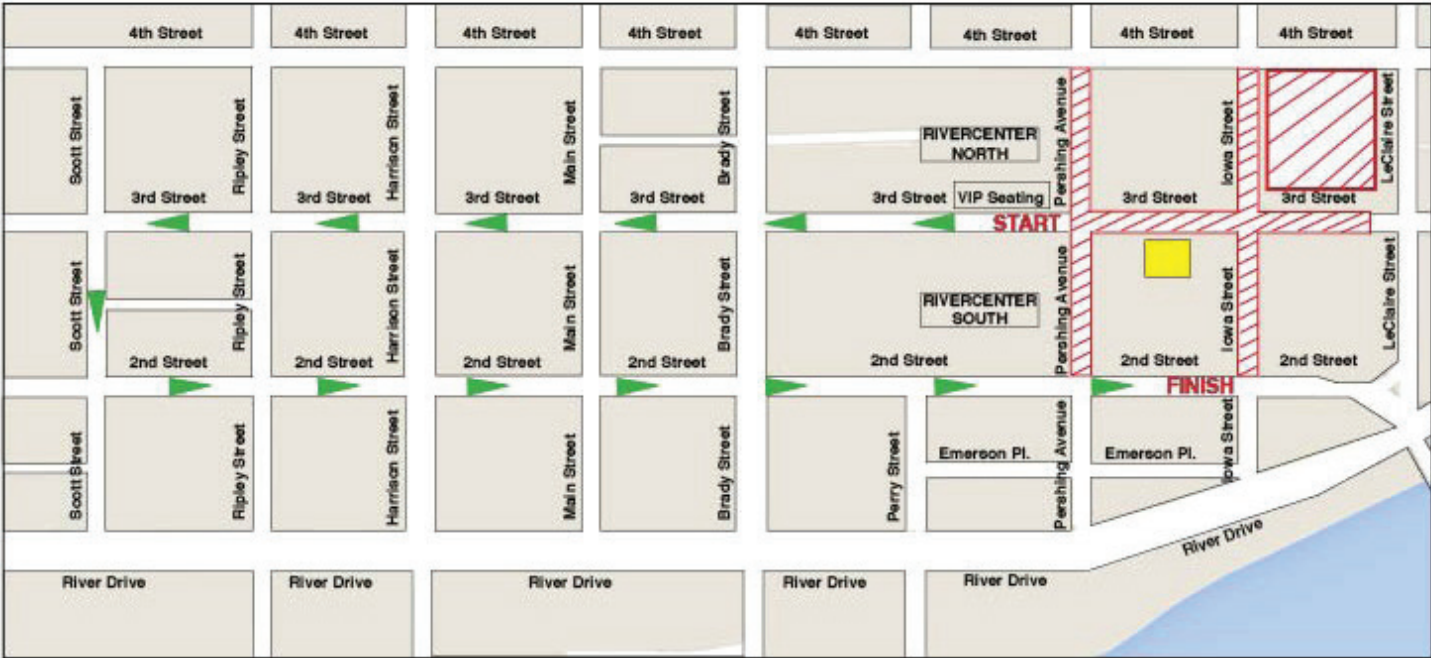

Q. Who runs Festival?

Festival of Trees is the largest fundraising event for Quad City Arts, a local nonprofit arts organization. Festival is chaired by volunteers along with Quad City Arts staff and a steering committee of over 80 members from communities on both sides of the river. The Steering Committee works year-round with hundreds of committee members to organize the event and each year more than 1800 volunteers staff the event.

Q. How does our Festival compare to other Festivals around the country?

Our local Festival of Trees ranks in the Top Ten in the United States and Canada by attendance and total dollars raised among such cities as Atlanta, Detroit, and

Q. Who provides the financial support for Festival?

Each year, more than 100 businesses serve as Festival sponsors, providing the critical seed money for Festival operations and/or in-kind donations that would otherwise be expensed to the event. Additionally, many designers generously donate their time and decorations to create the incredible designs that are shown and sold at Festival. More than 400 local businesses provide donations, services, and discounts for the event and in turn, the Festival of Trees Steering Committee has a strict policy of supporting local businesses whenever possible. Festival's success depends on the support of the thousands of people

Q. When is the best time to attend Festival if I want to browse leisurely through the trees?

Most people attend Festival during the holiday weekend when family and friends are in town, and evenings seem to be the most popular time of day. Q. I really want to go to Festival, where do I get tickets?

General admission tickets are sold online starting November 1 and we have transitioned to CASHLESS ADMISSION (debit/credit card ONLY) at the door. We recommend buying your tickets early and skipping the line! Discounted adult general admission tickets are available at Quad City area Kwik Star locations November 1 – November 15. IH Mississippi Valley Credit Union members receive BOGO general admission on same ticket value or less. Special event tickets are sold online at qcfestivaloftrees.com. Seating at all special events is by reservation only unless otherwise noted.

Q. How are the trees and the many other designs sold at Festival of Trees?

The very first opportunity anyone has to purchase the designer trees, door designs, holiday entries, and hearth & home designs is at the Festival Premiere party, Friday, November 19. Tickets are \$50 each and can be purchased at qcfestivaloftrees.com or by calling (309) 793-1213. Each item will be for sale via silent auction bidding or raffle. We are using MOBILE BIDDING technology this year, so it's simple and easy to bid and buy at the event or at home! Those items not purchased at the "Buy it Now" price will be on continuous silent auction throughout Festival. This means that for the remaining days of Festival, November 20 – November 28, the public may continuously bid on these items. Bidding will close on Sunday, November 28 at 4:00 p.m. Winners will be alerted that evening. For raffled items, the \$1 chances continue throughout the entire 10 days of Festival. Winners are drawn at 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, November 28, and called that evening. Trees, and Hearth & Home will be delivered. Small Wonders, gingerbread, stockings and ornaments may be picked up at Festival 6-8 p.m. on Sunday, November 28, or on Monday. Holiday Entry and Door designs may be picked up Monday, November 29, 8 a.m.-5 p.m. Bring your receipt! Small wonders, gingerbread items and ornaments are purchased by removing the price tag and taking it to the Information Booth for payment. You

Q. Where can I go to get a good bite to eat?

There are places inside Festival that you can get a quick bite to eat. TreatShoppe, located in the Great Hall, sells a variety of sweet candy treats, ice cream, and popcorn sure to satisfy snack cravings. The RiverCenter also has concessions available for purchase in the Great Hall.

Q. What kind of accommodations do you have for the elderly and is there an ATM located inside Festival?

The RiverCenter is wheelchair accessible with ramps and elevators. The Sales & Information Booth inside the Great Hall, has wheelchairs available to check-out for the elderly with limited mobility. Wheelchairs are provided on a first come first serve basis, and require an ID to check-out. IDs will be held until chairs are returned. The RiverCenter has an ATM inside the building for public use located at the 3rd Street Entrance, however, don't forget that our admission gates are debit/credit card ONLY this year!
