

**PETITION TO AMEND DAWSON COUNTY, MONTANA RESOLUTION NO. 2025-29
DAWSON COUNTY DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS
(HEIGHT LIMITS AND SET BACK REGULATIONS)**

If 15% of the qualified electors in the County of Dawson, State of Montana, excluding the City of Glendive, the Town of Richey and the Part 1 Zoning Districts of Forest Park and Highland Park, sign this petition and the total number of qualified electors signing is 303, then this measure will appear on the June 2, 2026 election ballot. If a majority of voters vote for this proposal at that election it will become law.

We, the undersigned qualified electors propose that the Dawson County Election Administrator place the following measure on the June 2, 2026 election ballot:

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

This measure proposes to amend the Dawson County Resolution #2025-29, Dawson County Development Regulations (Height Limits and Set Back Regulations). If adopted the measure would amend portions of Section II of the regulations as to height limitations, and repeal setback requirements. The amendment would also repeal language inconsistent with these amendments.

- YES on limiting height of tall structures to 250 feet by amendment and repeal of portions of Dawson County Resolution #2025-29, Section II, Dawson County Development Regulations

- NO on limiting height of tall structures to 250 feet by amendment and repeal of portions of Dawson County Resolution #2025-29, Section II, Dawson County Development Regulations

Qualified electors are urged to read the complete text of the measure which appears as an attachment. A signature on this petition is only to put the measure on the ballot and does not necessarily mean a signer agrees with the measure.

This petition was approved as to form on 2-3-2026, 2026 and all signatures must be collected within ~~90~~ days. by March 4, 2026

WARNING A person who purposefully signs a name other than the person's own to this petition, who signs more than once for the same issue at one election, or who signs when not a legally registered Montana voter is subject to a \$500 fine, 6 months in jail, or both.

Each person is required to sign the person's name and list the person's address or telephone number in substantially the same manner as on the person's voter registration form or the signature will not be counted.
