To whom this may concern:

My name is Nicholas heinrich I am writing this to get my grievances out in the open. A little over a year ago my wife's mother died a horrible death due to cancer. Leaving myself and my wife to deal with things. Neither one of us has gone through the process before and we're learning on the way. So after we grieved her loss we got help and got things lined up. We put the estate through probate. In which I am still not sure if it is 100 percent final yet. The property is in a bit of an eye sore we get that. And have been slowly clearing it out. All last summer I had hired lawn care done and then started again this year. Again may not have been as fast as people would have like to see. But it is getting done. I am only 1 person and I do have a very demanding job where I am out of the state for months at a time. So what prompted this whole ordeal was my lawn care company had gone to property to mow and there was 2 vehicles parked inside the fence in back yard. He was interested in purchasing it. He went back to look at it and they had been removed from the property. Made several phone calls tracked down vehicles than got sheriff ms department involved got to the bottom of that situation. Here is where things get kinda sketchy if you will. Talked to district sanitarian all he could tell me was that he was looking into who owes property but did not give authorization to pick up any vehicles and also told me he was going to post notice but had not done it yet and that he knows nothing. Funny all of a sudden there is a posting on city hall door about said property dates back to the 13th we didn't talk till the 19th but yet he knew nothing and couldn't answer any questions. Than talking to the neighbors everyone talked to said that property was deemed abandoned. Where would this information have come from because the property has been in probate and the info of who was the responsible contact person would have in fact been very easy to find. So we have not received any notices, no phone calls, no certified letter of complaints, we didn't even get the chance to rectify any notice of a issue or even knew there was a in issue. But the mayor of our fine city takes it upon herself to go to property mow and than start removing garbage and whatever else she wanted without consulting the executive of the estate???? I don't know a lot about the way things work but I do know that notices must be given and things like that. What would have happened if our city leader had fallin got hurt while trespassing on our property. So if the proper channels would have been addressed. Don't the public works depart do the work? I am pretty sure that you can't just go and do things like that even with permission from city attorney's. WE HAD NO CLUE OF ANYTHING . So as far as I am concerned I hold her responsible for trespassing and missing items from property. I did talk to mayor today on phone and all I got out of the whole conversation was I did nothing wrong and I can pretty much do what I want and get away with it talking pictures and what not for evidence. Still pretty sure you need permission to do that. While there are many properties around Glendive with junk boats, vehicles, garbage. That has been a problem for lot longer than my property so why the sudden interest in my property. All the contact information for estate has been in paper and filed in Dawson county. The city police department was able to find us and get ahold of us about a water leak inside the house this winter that we addressed. so in lean to all this I believe our rights have been violated and will be contacting a attorney.
