The Grand Jury charges:

On or about January 21, 2014, in the District of South Dakota and elsewhere, the defendant, Wehnona Stabler, did willfully and knowingly make and cause to be made, and use and cause to be used, in a matter within the jurisdiction of a department or agency of the United States, a false writing or document, knowing the same to contain a materially false, fictitious, and fraudulent statement, namely the defendant, Wehnona Stabler, submitted to the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Indian Health Service, a Confidential Financial Disclosure Report Form OGE-450 subscribing as true that she had not received any gifts greater than \$350 from one source. The statement was then and there false because, as the defendant, Wehnona Stabler, then and there knew, she had indeed received a \$5,000 gift from Stanley Patrick Weber, which was subject to reporting, all in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1001.
