The Defendant states the following facts are true, and the parties agree that they establish a factual basis for the offenses to which Defendant is pleading guilty pursuant to Fed. R. Crim. P. 11(b)(3):

On or about between January 1, 2016, and January 3, 2016, at Pine Ridge, in Indian country, in the District of South Dakota, the Defendant, Elizabeth Ann LeBeau, a/k/a Ann LeBeau, did unlawfully kill Emily Bluebird by acting together with Fred Quiver, a/k/a Fred Brings Plenty, to bring about Emily Bluebird's death by strangulation. The Defendant also struck Emily Bluebird in the head with a hammer multiple times.

After Bluebird was murdered, the Defendant assisted Quiver by destroying and disposing of evidence of the murder in order to prevent their apprehension, trial, and punishment.

LeBeau is an "Indian" under the provisions of 18 U.S.C. § 1153 in that she is eligible for enrollment with a federally recognized Tribe. The offense occurred

at Pine Ridge, South Dakota, which is within the exterior boundaries of the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation. This location is "Indian country" within the provisions of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1151 and 1153.
