## **MEETING AGENDA**

- 1. Call to Order
- 2. In accordance with M.G.L. c. 111, § 31, the Board will vote on the following:
  - A determination that a public health emergency exists due to the current state of the COVID-19 Pandemic;
  - A mandatory indoor mask requirement in all public indoor spaces; and
  - Institution of a vaccine requirement in order to enter certain businesses including,

- 1. Indoor Entertainment, Recreational, and Event Venues, including movie theaters, music or concert venues, commercial event and party venues, museums and galleries, professional sports arenas and indoor stadiums, convention centers and exhibition halls, performing arts theaters, bowling alleys, and other recreational centers;
- 2. Indoor Food Services, including indoor portions of food service establishments offering food and drink, including restaurants, bars, and all indoor dining areas of food service establishments. The requirements of this Order shall not apply to any food service establishment offering food and/or drink exclusively for off-premises or outdoor consumption, or to a food service establishment providing charitable food services such as soup kitchens.
- 3. Indoor Gyms and Fitness Settings, including commercial gyms, fitness, yoga/pilates/barre/dance studios, boxing/kickboxing gyms, fitness boot camps, indoor pools, and other facilities used for conducting group fitness classes.
- 3. New Business/Scheduling of Future Agenda Items
  - Items that could not be anticipated prior to the posting of the agenda

Please note that in light of the opportunity for public comment at the prior meeting, this meeting will not include a public comment period.
