STERN GROVE FESTIVAL

Celebrating 88 years of Free Music in the Bay Area



Rosalie M. Stern purchased Stern Grove and gifted it to San Francisco in 1931, honoring her late husband, Sigmund Stern. Originally homesteaded by George Greene in the 1840s, the Grove transformed from sand dunes into a lush oasis, with the Greene family planting the first eucalyptus trees and building the Trocadero Inn, a lively retreat until 1916.

Mrs. Stern recognized the Grove's natural acoustics and envisioned a public park offering free music, dance, and theater. On June 4, 1932, Stern Grove was dedicated, and two weeks later, the San Francisco Symphony held its first concert there. In 1938, she founded the Stern Grove Festival Association, ensuring the concerts would always be free and open to all.

Mrs. Stern led the Festival until her passing in 1956. Her daughter, Elise Stern Haas, and granddaughter, Rhoda Haas Goldman, continued her legacy. After Rhoda's death in 1996, her son Dr. Douglas E. Goldman became Board Chair, serving until 2020. Today, his son, Matthew Goldman, leads the Festival, marking five generations of family leadership.

Stern Grove has become one of Northern California's most beloved concert sites, offering free performances by Grammy winners, Hall of Famers, and emerging artists. Every summer, thousands gather in the eucalyptus-shaded amphitheater to enjoy music in this idyllic setting.

While owned by the City, the Festival relies on nearly \$3 million in annual donations from individuals, foundations, businesses, and volunteers. Thanks to community support, Stern Grove Festival has delivered free performances for over eight decades — and with your help, will continue to do so for generations to come.

Rosalie M. Stern purchased Stern Grove and gave it as a gift to the City of San Francisco in 1931, in memory of her husband Sigmund, a prominent civic leader. Mrs. Stern determined that the site would be preserved as a park in which the public could enjoy admission-free music, dance, and theater performances.

WHERE IS IT?


Stern Grove is at the corner of 19th Ave & Sloat Blvd in San Francisco - a magical amphitheater surrounded by Redwood and Eucalyptus Trees

- The Main GA entrance is located at **23rd & Wawona** which will be open at 10am for breakfast, coffee, merch and more! The other GA entrance is at 19th & Sloat. VIP is located on Vale Ave. & Crestlake Dr.
- Gates open at 12pm (noon)
- Concerts begin at 1pm and end between 4-5pm

SERVICE FOR SENIORS/ADA PATRONS

Stern Grove Festival is Wheelchair, ADA and Senior (65+) accessible.

All attendees requiring Wheelchair, ADA, or Senior accommodations must have a General Admission ticket to attend.

ADA and Senior seating areas are first-come-first-serve once you are inside the Festival and available for 1 guest and 1 companion

SHUTTLE SERVICE is available for Wheelchair users, those requiring ADA accommodations, and seniors only.

Round trip shuttle service is from the 19th and Sloat Entrance.

WHEELCHAIR

There are three reserved ADA compliant wheelchair seating areas available inside the Concert Meadow.

Access to these spaces is a short distance from the Shuttle drop-off area.

ADA SEATING AREA

The Festival has created a first-come, first-served seating area inside the Concert Meadow for those requiring ADA Accommodations but are not using a wheelchair.





THE CALIFORNIA HONEYDROPS
THE DIP



The California Honeydrops bring the ultimate feel-good funk, soul, and New Orleans-style party vibes to the Grove! Born in Oakland and raised on the streets (and BART stations) of the Bay, this band turns every show into a joyful dance party with their blend of vintage R&B, Southern soul, and second-line swagger. With sold-out tours, major festival slots, and a devoted local following, they're the kind of band that makes you forget your shoes, your phone, and your problems.

CHANNEL TRES
ASTU



Channel Tres is bringing his seductive blend of West Coast house, hip-hop, and R&B for a bass-heavy, body-moving Sunday you won't forget. Hailing from Compton, he's flipped the script on dance music with his deep baritone vocals and effortlessly cool beats—earning fans like Tyler, the Creator and Robyn, and turning global dance floors into his playground. Channel's live set is part club, part sermon, all swagger—get ready to dance under the trees.

JUNE 29

SLEATER-KINNEY
DESTROY BOYS



Sleater-Kinney is pure Pacific Northwest punk rock royalty, and they're crashing the Grove with their fierce riffs, fearless energy, and feminist fire. Born in the riot grrrl scene of the '90s, this legendary duo has released ten studio albums, landed on Rolling Stone's "Greatest Guitarists" list, and built a cult following that spans generations. Expect sharp lyrics, raw emotion, and the kind of electric catharsis that only happens when the redwoods shake.

JULY 6

SF SYMPHONY
with special guest **TAIMANE**



The San Francisco Symphony returns to their roots at the Grove—literally the first performers to ever grace this stage back in 1938. One of the most celebrated orchestras in the world, they bring classical mastery with a modern twist, and this year they're teaming up with ukulele virtuoso **Taimane** for a genre-blurring, soul-stirring performance under the trees. From Beethoven to bold new sounds, this concert is where tradition meets transcendence.

JULY 13

PHANTOGRAM
HA VAY



Phantogram weaves hypnotic electronic pop and gritty trip-hop into the kind of sonic swirl that feels tailor-made for the Grove at golden hour. Hailing from upstate New York, the duo of Sarah Barthel and Josh Carter has racked up platinum records, Coachella sets, and collabs with Big Boi and Flaming Lips—earning their place as icons of moody, modern cool. Think pulsing beats, lush vocals, and a full-body experience beneath the trees.

GIRL TALK
CHROMEO



Girl Talk is the mad scientist of the mashup, a Pittsburgh-born DJ and producer who's turned thousands of samples into pure, ecstatic chaos. His live shows are legendary—sweaty, euphoric explosions of pop, rap, rock, and nostalgia where the crowd becomes part of the spectacle. **Chromeo**, the self-proclaimed "Funklordz" from Montreal, bring the perfect blend of synth-funk, disco, and electro-pop to the picnic table. Known for sharp suits & sharper guitar licks, Dave 1 and P-Thugg have been grooving across the globe for over two decades.

Orville Peck is the masked crooner reinventing country music with a voice as deep as the canyon and a style as bold as a rhinestone rodeo. Hailing from South Africa, Peck has become a global queer icon with a sound that fuses classic outlaw country, dreamy Americana, and cinematic drama. His soaring ballads and boot-stomping anthems have landed him collaborations with everyone from Willie Nelson to Shania Twain. Under the redwoods, it's going to feel like the world's most glamorous campfire singalong.

Michael Franti brings sunshine, soul, and social consciousness to every stage—and there's no better place to feel that energy than right here. Born and raised in the Bay Area, Franti is a musical activist whose infectious blend of reggae, hip-hop, funk, and folk has made him a global ambassador of good vibes. From chart-topping hits like "Say Hey (I Love You)" to barefoot dancing with fans, his shows are all about connection, compassion, and straight-up joy. It's not just a concert—it's a celebration of life, community, and the power of music to bring us all together.
