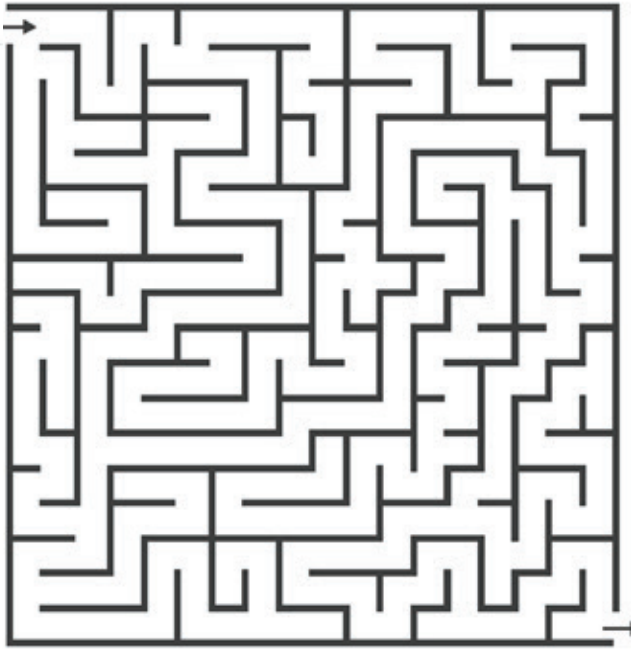
# BADGER COLORING CONTEST
