Your applicant conducted an investigation and received information from other officers and other sources as follows:

See attached investigative and police reports.

On 3/24/2014 this officer served a search warrant on Mike Block's property 5808 180th St. Sibley, IA for a stolen John Deere mower (Exhibit #1). The mower was recovered at the property and while in the building where the mower was stored this officer noticed the engine covers from a White tractor leaning against the east wall of the shed. This officer was able to see the front side of the panels without moving them and found that two of the three panels had "Class of 75" written on them. This matched the panels of a tractor that was reported stolen back on 10/14/2013 west of Sibley, IA (See Exhibit #2). This officer also saw a White tractor on the yard that was missing its side panels and appeared to be the same model and style of tractor that was stolen. This officer also observed a white enclosed single axle trailer parked next to the mower that looked as if it had decals removed. There were also parts of a decal on the floor of the building that appeared to have a Sanborn, IA phone number on it. There was a New Holland round baler in the shed that was missing its side panels and other parts. This officer also saw a newer looking New Holland round baler parked on the yard and it appeared to have old side panels on it. This officer is aware that a New Holland round baler was stolen out of O'Brien County this past fall and there were a lot of baling type equipment stolen in our area also. Mike Block does custom baling for an income and would have use for baling items. There was also a black PJ trailer parked on the yard and it matches a stolen one out of O'Brien County (See Exhibit #3). This officer believes that there are numerous stolen items on the property and that Block has items hidden on the property and in his out building. The items located at his property are items consistent with his work as a custom baler and as a construction worker. In recent months items used in baling were stolen in our area and from surrounding counties. At one location a shop truck with a white fiberglass utility containing tools was taken, also a Sitrex rake and a gray 15' foot Loftness stalk chopper (See Exhibit #4). This officer also took a report of a stolen hay rack from the hay auction site in Sibley which is a place Block uses to sell his bales. (See Exhibit #6) O'Brien County also had a report of stolen hay rakes near our county line. It is this officer's belief that because of the amount of visible items that appear to be stolen that there will be more stolen items located on the property and in the out buildings.

Your applicant conducted an investigation and received information from other officers and other sources as follows:

See attached investigative and police reports.

On 7/6/2013 Sibley equipment reported that they had a 2010 diesel John Deere 997 mower stolen from their business. (See Exhibit#1) Photos of an identical mower were provided to this officer and also a description of the mower. The mower had been traded in recently along with another mower identical to it from the Osceola County Conservation Department. On 3/21/2014 this officer was assisting O'Brien County Sheriff's Office with investigation of stolen hay. This officer went to a farm acreage belonging to Mike Block at 5808 180th St. Sibley, IA (See Exhibit #4). This officer had seen Block at the acreage earlier in the day and had stopped to talk with him about the O'Brien County case. Block was not home at the time, but while on the yard this officer noticed a mower parked in a shed that matched the description of the mower that was stolen. This officer while still inside the partol vehicle photographed the shed and the mower parked inside it (See Exhibit #2). 3/24/2014 this officer then checked the report on the stolen mower and found the picture of the identical mower (See Exhibit #3) and it matched what could be seen of the mower parked at the Block acreage. This officer also stopped at the John Deere dealership where the mower had been stolen from and talked with Mark Langstraat and he stated that this model of mower isn't very common and they are less common with the brush guard. This officer showed him the picture taken from the Block residence of the mower and he believed it was probably their mower. Langstraat stated that the guard is a \$500 option so few people choose to put them on. This officer seeks permission from the court to go to the Block property and examine the mower to see if it is infact the stolen mower and then to seize the mower if it is the one that was stolen.




