As I have stated to the city council, although we disagree on many issues, I hold no bias against religious people generally or against members of Cornerstone, and would stand up to protect their legal rights the same as any other protected class.

You may not believe this, but all I can do is prove it with my actions.

I hope you and your family can accept my apology and we can move forward to make our community a better place by working together.
