Bud Day Center for Civic Engagement at Morningside College and is a public opinion survey that measures the attitudes of Iowa residents on a variety of public policy issues and on the performance of the state's legislative and executive branches of government. GUN LAWS AND RESTRICTIONS

Less Strict: 16%
Kept Same: 53%
More Strict: 27%
Undecided: 4%

Less Strict: 7%
Kept Same: 27%
More Strict: 58%
Undecided: 8%

How effective do you feel Iowa's gun free zones are in preventing gun violence?

Households with Firearms

Never Effective: 28%
Rarely Effective: 16%
Sometimes Effective: 23%
Usually Effective: 18%
Always Effective: 6%
Undecided: 9%

Households without Firearms

Never Effective: 14%
Rarely Effective: 17%
Sometimes Effective: 30%
Usually Effective: 22%
Always Effective: 4%
Undecided: 12%

POLLING SOURCE INFORMATION: The poll includes responses from 994 Iowa adults and the survey was conducted from May 2 to May 12, 2018, via computer-assisted telephone interviews (landlines and cell phones included). In some cases, data was rounded.
