accessing the root zone. As a result, plants, including trees, are vulnerable to disease and

even death.

· Surface crust: Surface crust, which blocks oxygen and water from penetrating the soil and tends to inflict areas

like footpaths and playgrounds due to heavy foot traffic, contributes to runoff and soil

erosion. Compacted soil is relatively simple to fix. But when untreated, compacted soil can threaten lawns, plants and other vegetation.
