Warrant Service: On January 31, 2022 Officers from the Easton Police Department had the occasion to come into contact with a white male identified as Charles Cox a 36 year old male from Federalsburg, MD. Officers were familiar with Cox and knew he had an outstanding warrant through the Easton Police Department. Cox was then taken into custody for the warrant without incident. According to the charging document the warrant was issued from an incident that took place in Easton, MD back on January 8, 2022 in the Aldi parking lot. Cox is being charged with one count of Robbery and one count of theft less than \$1500.00. Cox was then taken to the Talbot County Detention Center where he was processed and is currently held o no bond.

Theft Less than \$100.00: On January 31, 2022 Officers from the Easton Police Department responded to Wal Mart located at 8155 Elliott Rd. Easton, MD in reference to a shoplifting. Upon arrival Officers met with loss prevention who stated two subjects entered the store and grabbed several iphone cases and then left without paying. Officers located the subjects who were identified as juveniles 16 years old and 11 years old from Easton, MD. Officers made contact with the parent of the juveniles where they were referred to juvenile services and released on scene. The total amount stolen/recovered was under \$1500.00.

CDS Possession Not-Marijuana: On February 1, 2022 Officers from the Easton Police Department conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for the driver not restrained by a seatbelt. Officers made contact with the driver identified as Nicholas Phebus a 26 year old male from Trappe, MD. During the course of the traffic stop a K9 scan was performed on the vehicle which resulted in a positive alert. Phebus was found to be in possession of Suboxone along with Adderall which he did not have a valid prescription to possess. Phebus was then issued a criminal citation for possession of a controlled dangerous substance not marijuana and released on scene.
