Wakeland might not have reached some of the heights that a few of its crosstown rivals have in recent years, but no Frisco ISD team has been as consistent.

The Wolverines have made the playoffs in 10 consecutive seasons, which is not only the longest current active streak in the city, it is the longest run in FISD history.

Wakeland went through a transition a year ago with the departure of Marty Secord, the only head coach the program had known since starting in 2006, and the arrival of Chan Isom.

The Wolverines got off to a 1-3 start, but got things turned around and went on to make

Myer has established himself as one of the top quarterbacks in Texas, claiming newcomer of the year honors as a sophomore and last season, was voted to the 6-5A Division I first team and was an honorable mention all-state honoree. Few quarterbacks can match Myer's numbers, as last season, he completed 242-of-358 passes for 3,492 yards and 39 touchdowns and he also flashed ability to make plays with his legs, rushing for four scores.

the playoffs and advance to the area round.

Wakeland is in position to make another run this season with 11 starters back in the fold.

The Wolverines return one of the most prolific passers in the state in senior quarterback

Brennan Myer, who completed 242-of-358 passes for 3,492 yards and 39 touchdowns and he also can make plays on the ground, as evidenced by his four rushing scores.

Wakeland is not a one-dimensional offense and senior running back Cooper Snyder provides the balance on the ground, logging 176 carries for 1,003 yards and 10 touchdowns a year ago and he is also a capable receiver, with 23 catches for 197 yards and three scores.

One of Myer's favorite targets on the outside also returns with senior Ashdyn Kahouch, who is coming off an all-district campaign that saw him haul in 53 receptions for 667 yards and 14 touchdowns.

The Wolverines have five players back on the defensive side of the ball.

Woolen was an all-district honoree after recording 42 tackles, with three for loss, four pass breakups and an interception, and fellow defensive back senior Campbell Martin had 93 tackles, with four for loss, four pass breakups and

an interception. Wakeland will be strong in the middle once again, led by senior linebacker Thomas Jelinek, who recorded 76 tackles, with 15.5 for loss, 3.5 sacks and 12 quarterback hurries last season.
