Subject: State of Texas Assessment of Academic Readiness (STAAR): 2018 Results

During the Tuesday, August 14, 2018, School Board Work Session, Trustees will receive information in accordance with TEC §39.030(b) and GISD Board Policy EKB (Legal) regarding the distribution of student state assessment performance results. This presentation will highlight student performance on the 2018 administrations of the State of Texas Assessment of Academic Readiness (STAAR) – grade 3-8 and End of Course (EOC) tests. The goal of this presentation is to provide Trustees with an awareness of student performance in this assessment program, at the All Students level (with comparisons to region and state performance), as well as GISD student performance of the four largest race/ethnicity student groups and economically disadvantaged student group.

In advance of the presentation, the following documents are provided for your review:

- A draft of the presentation slides to be shared;
- A six-year longitudinal look at district, Region 10, and state performance for the all students group by grade and content area at the *Approaching Grade Level* and *Meets Grade Level*, and *Masters Grade Level* performance; and
- District and campus percentage of tested students reaching *Approaching Grade Level*, *Meets Grade Level*, and *Masters Grade Level* performance levels.

Assessment Summary Results are produced for every test and administration of the state assessment program for state, region, district, and campus levels. Copies of the district and campus summary reports have been posted to the GISD shared Google team drive (https://drive.google.com/open?id=1lvuk_Ui2XQBZmuEFubqRVVD-MAceY8i4). While TEA no longer makes available original format soft copies, the data is accessible through the Analytic Portal (<https://txreports.emetric.net/?domain=4&report=5>).

- Students at this level have met the minimum passing standard**





Meets Grade Level


Masters Grade Level


Percentage of Tested Students Earning Meets Grade Level



2018 STAAR MATHEMATICS




Percentage of Tested Students Earning Meets Grade Level


Percentage of Tested Students Earning Meets Grade Level


Percentage of Tested Students Earning **Meets** Grade Level


Percentage of Tested Students Earning **Meets** Grade Level
