

**CONSUMPTION RESTRICTIONS AND RESTAURANTS; AMENDMENTS TO ORDINANCE SEPTEMBER 20, 2022, AND TO THE CODE OF ORDINANCES AS FOLLOWS:**

**Chapter 4, Sec. 4-9:**

Notwithstanding any of the other provisions of this article, the sale of beer and light wines by the drink shall be lawful within restaurants and cafes. Restaurants and cafes shall be defined as those establishments which are enclosed buildings in the primary business of preparing and serving food for consumption within those premises and who derive 50 percent of their gross receipts from the sale of such prepared food. Such sales shall be permitted between the hours 10:00 a.m. and 12 midnight, Monday through Saturday and 12 p.m. (noon) and 11:00 p.m. on Sunday, For restaurants and cafes within the Pine Hill District, sales shall be permitted between the hours 10:00 a.m. and 12 midnight, Monday through Saturday and on Sunday shall be permitted between the hours of 10 a.m. through 11 p.m. It shall be unlawful for persons under the age of 21 to sell, dispense, deliver or serve beer or light wines in restaurants and cafes.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This ordinance shall be effective upon approval as required by law, execution and publication.

The above and foregoing Ordinance, having been first reduced to writing, was introduced by Alderman Ron Dyal seconded by Alderman Damian McKay and adopted by the following roll call vote:
