ANNUAL TAX BUDGETS

- ▶ General Sales: \$20.0M
- ▶ SUA: \$10.0M
- ▶ Transportation: \$10.0M
- ▶ Use Tax: \$4.6M
- ▶ Visitor: \$1.8M

DID YOU KNOW?

Use Tax is collected on tangible personal property purchased outside the state and brought into the state for storage, use or consumption. This helps ensure fairness between online and in-store purchases and helps prevent unfair competition from out-of-state retailers.



Visitor Tax is collected on stays at a hotel, bed and breakfast, or short-term rental within Stillwater. The revenue supports visitor development and quality of life amenities.

WHAT AM I LOOKING AT?

The first arrow in each box refers to this month’s taxes compared to the same month last year. The second arrow refers to the total taxes reported so far for FY26 compared to the same point in FY25.

A NOTE ON NUMBERS

Data for the March 2026 Tax Report is based off of January 2026 transactions that were reported to the Oklahoma Tax Commission in February and apportioned to the City in March.


















