

Autumn Artfest 2019

This is the 23rd Fine Art Exhibition presented by The Live Oak Artists Guild at the Suwannee River Regional Library in Live Oak. Award winners will participate in a Featured Exhibit at the library following Artfest. The show is designed to allow a maximum number of artists to participate, thereby encouraging the growth of both interest and participation in the visual arts.

The Live Oak Artists Guild invites community schools to tour the Artfest exhibit.

Removal of Artwork

All artwork is to remain on display until the end of the exhibit. For security/liability purposes, no one can take down any artwork **before 4 pm** on Friday September 22nd, 2019. Any artist who removes work from the show before the closing time will not be permitted to enter the Autumn Artfest the following year. Work not selected for awards must be picked up at the Suwannee River Regional Library on **Friday, September 22, 2019 from 4 pm to 6 pm.** Work left from the show after 6 pm Sept. 22, will not be the responsibility of the art guild or the library. Award winning artwork in the Featured Exhibit must be picked up at the Suwannee River Regional Library on October 4, 2019 from 1 pm until 5 pm. The same rules apply to work not picked up at the designated time.

All artists may submit up to two (2) works for display. Exhibit space is limited and work will be accepted until the show is filled. If your artwork is not accepted, you will be notified.

Artwork will be delivered to the Suwannee River Regional Library on Thursday, September 5, 2019, from 5 to 7 pm.

Awards

Awards for the Autumn Artfest 2019 will be determined by the entries and donations received. There will be a minimum of \$1,000. in awards. At the end of the Artfest Exhibit, artwork selected for these awards will be exhibited at a special "Featured Exhibition" at the Suwannee River Regional Library from September 23, 2019 until October 4, 2019.

Reception

An opening reception will be held on Friday, **September 6, 2019 from 5 pm to 7 pm** at the Suwannee River Regional Library. All participating artists, their guests, award sponsors and the public are invited to attend.

Media Categories

Acceptable media for the 2019 exhibition are:

1. **Photography (digitally altered or enhanced photos must be noted on application).**
2. **Painting (oil, acrylic, watercolor, mixed media).**
3. **Drawing (pastel, pencil, charcoal, pen & ink).**
4. **Three dimensional media (wood, stone, metal, pottery). No furniture.**

All entries in the painting or drawing categories must be created on canvas, paper or drawing board. No entries on other surfaces are eligible.

Works created from published photographs, advertisements and kits are not acceptable.

Work must be original and created solely by the exhibiting artist. No nudity will be accepted. All entries must have been completed within the past two years and must not have been exhibited previously in Autumn Artfest. The Autumn Artfest committee will have the final decision on the acceptability of all works. An application is a commitment to exhibit. Incomplete applications will not be accepted. Applications are non-refundable and non-transferable. All artists 18 years or older are eligible.

Presentation

Two dimensional artwork must not exceed 3 feet in any direction including frame, must be ready to hang and not weigh more than 10 pounds. Please use **plexiglas** instead of glass. Use hanging wire. **No saw tooth hangers will be accepted.**

Three dimensional work must be stable and not exceed 4 feet in any direction. Artists must provide their own **stable** stand, or pedestal.

Labels for the artwork will be provided upon delivery. Mark "top" on all artwork where orientation may be questioned.
