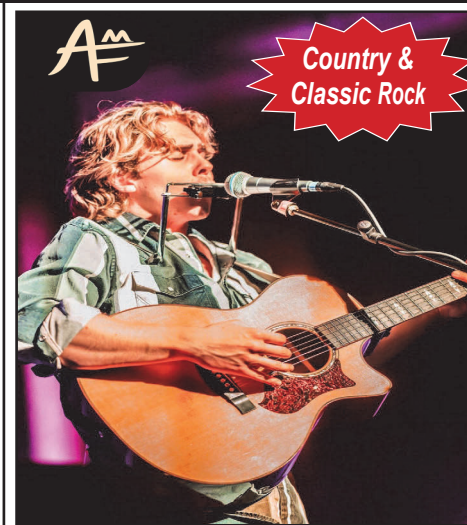

Lea Thompson helps to guide 'Anna Pigeon'

Q: I see Lea Thompson being credited as the director of the new show "Anna Pigeon." When did she start directing? — Tony Bray, via e-mail

A: By taking up that pursuit in addition to her acting career, which dates back to her early-1980s appearances in fast-food commercials, Thompson actually is keeping it all in the family. Her husband is Howard Deutch, who directed her in "Some Kind of Wonderful" (1987) and who also counts "Pretty in Pink" (1986) and "Grumpier Old Men" (1995) among his films. He's now on the creative team for ABC's "Will Trent."

Thompson, who has held the screen rights to the "Anna Pigeon" novels for many years (and who also is an executive producer of the USA Network series), broke into directing in the mid-2000s with a couple of the Hallmark "Jane Doe" mystery movies in which she also starred. She then directed several episodes of "Switched at Birth," the 2013-17 ABC Family/ Freeform series in which she was a cast regular as well.

For her first feature film as a director, Thompson guided a cast including daughters Madelyn and Zoey Deutch in the 2017 comedy-drama "The Year of Spectacular Men." Her other directing since has been in episodic television, with "The Goldbergs" especially fruitful for her since she guided 10 stories on that now-ended ABC sitcom.

ABC's "American Housewife," CBS's "Mom" and "Young Sheldon," The CW's "Stargirl," Paramount+'s "Star Trek: Picard" and Syfy's "Resident Alien" have been among other shows on which Thompson has called the shots. She also has joined her hus-

band on "Will Trent" by directing several episodes of that series.

Q: It was fun to see Tom Cruise in "Cocktail" on ABC recently, and to hear the song "Kokomo" in it. Was that the last hit that The Beach Boys had? — Ray Linden, Dubuque, Iowa

A: Pretty much, with the tune reaching the top spot on American pop charts in 1988, the year the movie was released. The perennially popular group released a number of other singles after that, including revisions of their own hits "I Can Hear Music," "Don't Worry Baby" and "Little Deuce Coupe" in 1996. However, they haven't again reached the chart heights that "Kokomo" last brought them to.

"Kokomo" also is a staple of live performances by the band, which continues to tour — with lead singer Mike Love the only original Beach Boy still doing shows with the group — though they postponed a number of this year's summer concerts to give Love a chance to "recharge," as a related statement put it. The tour will pick up in late September and, as of this writing, is slated to continue until mid-November, with an additional show scheduled for next May in Enoch, Alberta, Canada.
