Snow Ending This Morning, Then COLD


Message of the Day

- ✓ Falling snow ending from north to south this morning, with very low visibility at times in snow bands especially due to gusty north winds blowing the snow.
- ✓ Travel impacts likely to linger after snow ends, due to slick and covered roads.
- ✓ NEAR RECORD COLD temperatures and wind chills into Tuesday.

✓ NEAR RECORD COLD temperatures and wind chills.


Where

Snow Ending This Morning, Then COLD

Situational Report Text Summary



Hazards: Snow and blowing snow, slick travel conditions, and near record cold temperatures and wind chills.



Areas Impacted: Most of Iowa.



Timing & Duration:

Snow: Tapering off from north to south this morning.

Travel Impacts: Persisting today until roads are cleared.

Cold: Through Tuesday, with lowest temperatures Tuesday morning.



Impacts: Reduced visibility below ½ mile at times in falling and blowing snow early this morning. Slick, icy, snow-covered roads impacting the morning commute and lingering today.



Certainty & Considerations: High confidence in very cold conditions. Cold impacts exacerbated due to unseasonably early nature of the event.

Next Update: No updates planned, unless conditions change.
