drop shots using Yamamotos set up on a drop shot. The popular lures are zara spooks,
S Wavers and Flicker Shads. Bass are still at the wall with catfish by the dam. We're still
70 % water capacity, well above the spillway, so no trout plants are scheduled. The fishin
derby is coming up in April. Our rental slips will fill fast, so make your plans early.

We will take reservations for the fishing derby one month prior.

Our last boat rental is at 2:30 p.m. and boats must be back in by 4:30 p.m.

We have an assortment of rentals from kayaks and canoes all the way up to our 20
person pontoon. All of our boats are first come, first serve. Reservations are not available
The weekends are very busy so if you want to rent a Pontoon Boat,
it is best to get here early and stand in line until we open.
