Adventure awaits in Northeastern Oklahoma

One of the primary features of Cherokee County is the great outdoors.

Oklahomans take great pride in the land and resources, and visitors can be sure they will catch a glimpse of the area's beauty.

The J.T. Nickel Family Nature and Wildlife Preserve is one area where visitors can experience all the Ozarks have to offer. The 1,700-acre preserve is in the Cookson area and overlooks the Illinois River

A diverse group of birds and other animals live in the preserve's mix of forest, scrubland, savanna and prairie. Elk are also known to move through the preserve as part of an effort to reintroduce the animal to Northeast Oklahoma. The Nickel Preserve is seen by many as one of the last landscape-scale opportunities to protect and restore a distinct Oklahoma Ozark ecosystem.

Visitors may also experience ranch life at Sycamore Springs Ranch outside of Peggs. The ranch hosts different rodeos, a variety of trophy hunters, animal auctions and company retreats. The 1,400 acres offers visitors beautiful trails and has luxury log cabins that can accommodate up to 44 people. Available are billiards, gaming tables, tennis, basketball courts and a big screen television. Guests can enjoy

the preserve as part of hot home-cooked meals an effort to reintroduce along with snacks and a the animal to Northeast continental breakfast.

For a more intimate experience, Twisted S Ranch, outside of Hulbert, offers a beautiful views for weddings or other events. The ranch offers special team-building races and other competitions for businesses and other groups looking for a day retreat.

Known as the Nursery Capital of the World, Cherokee County's many nurseries are an important part of rural life in the county. Along with shrubs, roses, trees, small fruits and different ground covers, unique selections are cultivated in the area. Family-owned Christmas tree farms are also available.
