

# What if my child is not a 3 or 4 on a standard?

 If 2 or 1 is the mark for an assessment, then you need to ask your student about their progress toward meeting the standard.

 Seeing a mark of 2 or 1 on an assessment is to be treated as a temporary score until the student reassesses for that standard.

#### Special Learning Needs

- Grades for students with Individual Education Plans (IEPs) and English Language Learners (ELLs) will be based upon the achievement or progress toward goals listed in their specific learning plans.
- Academic achievement is measured on student learning and progress toward the standards, not a comparison of student to student. This allows the teacher to accurately measure a student's progress based upon that student's ability.
