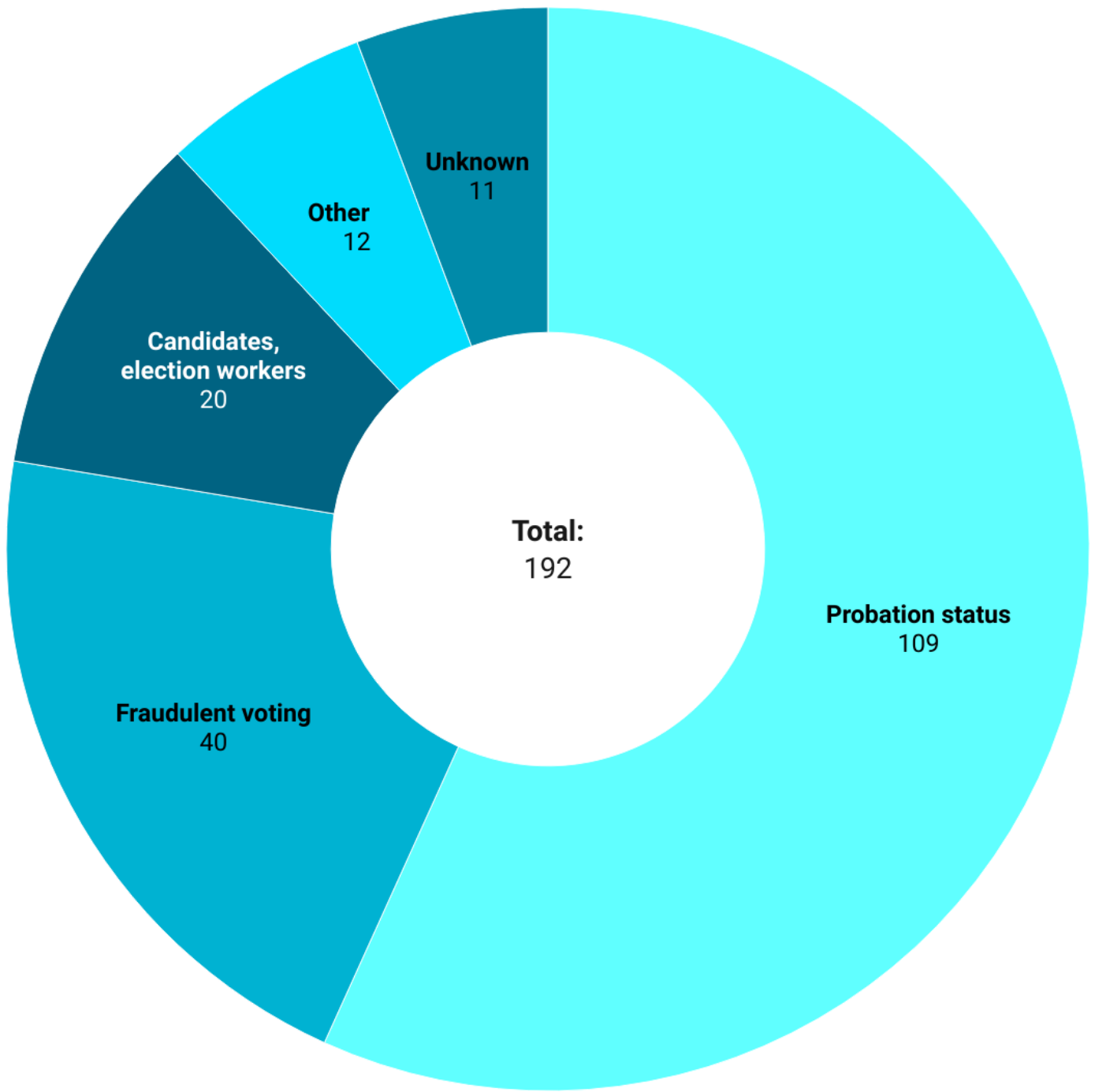


A voter's probation status was the biggest reason for election fraud prosecutions

From 2012-2022, Wisconsin district attorneys brought fewer than 200 cases – the equivalent of 0.0006% of votes cast – with a voter's probation status as the most-common reason.

- Probation status (109)
- Fraudulent voting (40)
- Candidates, election workers (20)
- Other (12)
- Unknown (11)



Note: Wisconsin Watch was able to determine the nature of allegations in 181 of 192 election fraud cases – 94.3% – charged between 2012 and 2022. The rest of the cases are categorized as "unknown." The "other" category includes cases with some evidence of voter error, three noncitizen voters, among others.
