

I would like to thank you for your attendance at the commission meeting on 03/05/25.


The City of Brunswick Commission has denied the application for an alcohol license for off premise consumption of beer, wine and liquor at 2300 Norwich Street. Pursuant to our ordinances, a public hearing was held at the March 5, 2025 Commission meeting. Additionally, if you wish to reapply for consideration in the time allotted by the ordinances, you may do so 6 months after denial.

Your Right to appeal based on the City Ordinance Section 3-26: All decisions approving, denying, suspending, revoking, refusing renewal of, or imposing conditions of probation upon alcohol beverage licenses shall be in writing, with the reasons therefore stated, and mailed or delivered to the applicant personally. Within 30 days of any such decision, any applicant or license holder aggrieved by the decision of the city commission regarding a license shall be afforded a public hearing with an opportunity to present evidence and cross-examine opposing witnesses.

You may submit a request to appeal by calling the City Clerk, Naomi Atkinson at 912-267-5529.
