THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

COUNT ONE

Distribution of Child Pornography
18 U.S.C. § 2252A(a)(2)

On or about August 28, 2018, in Camden County, within the Southern District of Georgia, the defendant,

VINCENT SANDERS,

did knowingly distribute or attempt to distribute child pornography, as that term is defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 2256(8)(A), that is, images visually depicting minors, individuals who had not attained the age of eighteen, engaged in sexually explicit conduct; said images having been transported in interstate or foreign commerce using a means or facility of interstate or foreign commerce.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2252A(a)(2).

COUNT TWO

Possession of Child Pornography

18 U.S.C. § 2252A(a)(5)(B)

Beginning at a time unknown to the Grand Jury but at least on or about September 25, 2018, in Camden County, within the Southern District of Georgia, the defendant,

VINCENT SANDERS,

did knowingly possess child pornography as defined in Title 18, United States Code, Section 2256(8)(A), that is, any visual depiction of a minor, any person under 18 years old, engaged in sexually explicit conduct, one or more of such images depicting a prepubescent minor or any person under 12 years old engaged in sexually explicit conduct said images having been shipped or transported using any means or facility of interstate or foreign commerce, including by computer.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 2252A(a)(5)(B).
