

Public Notice

Pursuant to the "Surface Mining Conservation and Reclamation Act" and the "Clean Streams Law," notice is hereby given that River Hill Coal Company, Inc., PO Box 141, Kylertown, PA 16847, has made application to the Department of Environmental Protection to revise the following surface coal mine permit and the related NPDES permit.

The McCloskey Operation, SMP #17793044 & NPDES #PA0119334 is being revised to amend the water treatment plan that will add a new NPDES discharge point 003, add 6.1 acres to the permit boundary for a new total permit acreage of 35.0 acres and to conduct surface mining activities (water treatment) within 100 feet of the northern right-of-way line of SR 1018 Pottersdale Road in Segment 0070, from Offset 250 to Offset 1200 (approximately 950 feet). The receiving streams for the permit are Saltlick Run and Upper Three Runs, both tributaries to the West Branch of the Susquehanna River. The operation is located in Karthaus Township, Clearfield County, and is on the north side of Pottersdale Road on the property of Boulton Enterprises, Inc., as shown on the Pottersdale, PA, U. S. Geological Survey 7.5-Minute Quadrangle.

Written comments, objections and requests for a public hearing or informal conference concerning this application may be submitted to the District Mining Manager at the above address within 30 days from the date of the final (4th) publication of this notice, and must include the persons name, address, telephone number and a brief statement as to the nature of the objection.
