## State Only Permit 17-00063

Code Section 127.462, the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) intends to amend the operating permit issued to Pennsylvania Grain Processing, LLC (PGP) for its facility located in Clearfield PA. State-Only Synthetic Minor Operating Permit (SMOP) 17-00063 was issued and last renewed on November 18, 2024.
