**LAKE LUCY SEWAGE AUTHORITY**

**Request for Consulting Engineering Services Proposals**

The Lake Lucy Sewage Authority in Clarion County is seeking Proposals from qualified Consulting Engineers familiar with the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program, the Pennsylvania Infrastructure Investment Authority (PENVEST) Program and other related Federal and State funding programs.

The Lake Lucy Sewage Authority desires to retain the services of a qualified Consulting Engineer to assist the Authority with various projects funded by the CDBG, PENVEST and other funding programs. Services requested of the Consulting Engineer include, but not be limited to, wastewater treatment plant operations services, and assisting the Authority with a project to complete the connection of the sewer system to the Farmington Sewer Treatment Plant owned, operated and maintained by Pennsylvania American Water located to the west of the North Clarion High School by installing force mains and gravity sewers, also including closed-circuit television inspection of the existing lines, making necessary replacements to ensure the system is operating properly and efficiently and abandoning the existing sewage treatment plant, cost estimates, design, specifications and bidding documents for projects, construction oversight and inspections and assistance with funding source(s) regulations compliance.

Original proposals will be received by Kristi Amato, Director, Clarion County Department of Planning and Development until 3:00 p.m., prevailing time, on June 22, 2026.
