

**NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT ORDINANCE
NO. 2026-01**

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Supervisors of Pike Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, will consider for enactment at a public meeting on July 1, 2026 at 4:30 p.m. at the Pike Township office, 2457 Curwensville-Grampian Hwy., Curwensville, PA an Ordinance titled:

“AN ORDINANCE OF PIKE TOWNSHIP, CLEARFIELD COUNTY TO DELEGATE TO THE SECRETARAY OF TRANSPORTAION AND ITS AUTHORITY TO ACQUIRE THE RIGHT-OF-WAY NECESSARY FOR THE REMOVAL OF THE PRATT PONY BRIDGE AND ADD CUL-DE-SACS”

The proposed Ordinance establishes rules for constructing, installing, and maintaining infrastructure within the public right-of-way, and officially delegates the Secretary of Transportation to administer right-of-way use authorizations and inspections on behalf of the Township
