

Public Notice

Pursuant to the PENNSYLVANIA CLEAN STREAMS LAW, the PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION Rules and Regulations, the SURFACE MINING CONSERVATION and RECLAMATION ACT, and the BITUMINOUS MINE SUBSIDENCE and LAND CONSERVATION ACT as amended, notice is hereby given that Rosebud Mining Company, 301 Market Street, Kittanning, PA 16201, has applied to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection to amend its existing underground coal mine CMAP #17041301 and related NPDES permit # PA0235628 known as the Penfield Mine. The revisions include the addition of 7,154 acres of Underground Permit and Subsidence Control Plan Areas.

The proposed additional Underground Permit and Subsidence Control Plan Areas are in Huston and Sandy Townships, Clearfield County and the approximate boundaries are located as follows: bounded on the north by Mountain Run; the east by Heath Run; the south by State Route 255 and Bennett Branch; and the west by Hungry Hollow Road. All of the described areas can be found on the Penfield and Sabula USGS, 7.5-minute series topographic maps.

A copy of the application is available for public inspection, and copying for a fee, by appointment at the Clearfield County Register and Recorder Office, 1 North Second Street, Clearfield, PA 16830. Written comments, objections, or a request for an informal conference may be submitted to the Department of Environmental Protection, District Mining Operations, 25 Technology Drive, California Technology Park, Coal Center, PA 15423, no later than thirty (30) days following the final (4th) publication of this notice and must include the person's name, address, telephone number and a brief statement as to the nature of the objection(s).
